FCMAT conversation with Anthony Bridges, Deputy Executive Officer (661) 706-0561

What we talked about:

What does FCMAT do?

"We do everything that is on this chart (Steve Crow's). We hire CBT and SSCAL when we need them to perform any particular part of the project." Upon probing, he revealed that they can help establish scope, do the analysis in every required area of the district, plus they include recommendations on implementation and can even guide us through implementation if that is what we require. The service includes a 6-month follow up visit to assist in any implementation needs.

How does FCMAT ensure objectivity and independence?

FCMAT is a government agency and receives considerable funding from the state, and only partial funding from client organizations. They do not need the work to stay in business, but they are happy to do the work as part of their mission.

FCMAT does work closely with leadership and involved parties in the studied organization. The President and administrative team is involved in establishing the scope of the project but does not have the ability to screen the outcomes of the project.

He claims that the outcomes in their reports are objective and neutral, not designed to support any particular perspective or position.

How do FCMAT's rates compare to CBT and other consultant firms?

Since the fixed costs of FCMAT are covered by their state revenue, they only pass along the direct costs of consulting to client organizations. This results in costs that are about ½ of CBT typically. FCMAT is limited by statute to charge no more than \$500 per person per day. FCMAT does call in consultants from CBT and SSCAL to perform certain aspects of projects. When they do this, these other organizations bill FCMAT at \$800 per day and FCMAT only recovers \$500 of that rate. Once the scope of the contract is set a firm price is established and will not be exceeded. Costs are tracked and if if less is expended than the quote, then we pay the lower amount of actual or quote.

How does FCMAT compare to CBT?

Collaborative Brain Trust is a collection of specialty contractors called in to work on projects requiring their expertise. This is a fairly small core organization paid directly by the studied clients. FCMAT is a governmental organization funded by the state and by charging a costrecovery rate to clients. FCMAT works with CBT and SSCAL when outside expertise is required. CBT is smaller and works mainly with Community Colleges. FCMAT is larger and works with K-14 which includes Community Colleges. Both have high expertise in Community Colleges.



The Fiscal Crisis and Management Assistance Team (FCMAT) was created by legislation in 1992 as an independent and external state agency. FCMAT's mission is to provide proactive and preventive fiscal, business and management review services that help local educational agencies comply with fiscal accountability standards and incorporate best practices.

FCMAT has performed more than 1,000 reviews for K-12 school districts, county offices of education, community colleges and charter schools. Management assistance requests represent approximately 75% of FCMAT's work. Areas of review include budgets and multiyear financial projections, reviews of business services, organizational effectiveness, special education, transportation services, maintenance and operations, and technology. Approximately 5% of FCMAT's work is on reviews assigned by the state Legislature or county superintendents and involves assistance with averting the need for emergency state loans. Assembly Bill 139 extraordinary audits, which review possible fraud or misuse of funds and are requested by county offices of education, also comprise approximately 5% of FCMAT's work.

The remaining 15% of FCMAT's work includes developing and providing numerous publications, software tools, workshops and professional development opportunities to help local educational agencies operate more effectively and fulfill their oversight responsibilities. FCMAT manages the California School Information Services (CSIS) database, the largest known K-12 educational data collection system.
