The Learning Assessment Committee will collaborate with the CAC and Academic Advisory Groups. We need to delete/archive courses not offered. Also discussed including Counseling group in these discussions. CAC, AAG and Learning Assessment Committees' each will have a few members decide which courses to archive/delete. Our catalog and our State list should match, and then we can update CurricUNET. Kim noted that there is no "delete" function for the State, only the option to make a course inactive. Fred suggested Kim attend to these meetings as well. Gamble would also like to participate. Catherine thinks it is important to have CAC represented. Laura mentioned that a process needs to be built to make this easier. Laura noted that a process needs to be built so that the originator is notified when the course meets the criteria.
