	is. Last CAC review was January, 2013.

	now? If we push forward will it impact the course with the State?	
	Kim says it will be approved by the State if the MOEs are okay as	
	far as she knows, but she is not sure.	
	Rachel asked what else needs to be updated. SLOs need an	
	update, but SLOs were not looked at as thoroughly in 2013. Fred	
	noted that MUSI 10B and C have never been assessed. The State	
	would be unaware of this.
