**AP 5220 Shower Facilities for Students**

The District maintains shower facilities for student use on campus that may be used by any registered student (including enrolled students who identify as homeless) who has paid enrollment fees and is in good standing with the District, regardless of housing status.

A homeless student is defined as a student who does not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes, but is not limited to, students who: are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelter; have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.

Shower facilities are located at the Physical Education facilities, gymnasium, general student's room. Operating hours for the use of facilities are available on the District's website. With the exception of use for classes, the District has identified the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., Monday through Friday, as a preferred time for use. In the event that these hours conflict with the hours of a special event, appropriate notice will be posted and the District will post alternative hours to use the facilities.
