Reference: Education Code 72285;
 California Administrative code, Title 5, 55750 – 55765

The College Catalog provides students with information on services, programs, regulations and academic and student related policies and procedures. It shall contain a statement of the mission and goals of the College, a description of instructional programs and courses, and Governing Board policies pertaining to: (A) admissions and residency requirements; (B) fees; (C) scholarship standards, including grading systems, credit by examination, standards for probation and dismissal and academic renewal, and (D) student rights and responsibilities. Changes in these policies shall be approved by the Board prior to their publication in subsequent catalog editions. The Board shall accept each edition of the College Catalog.

The College reserves the right to make changes in policies, regulations, fees and programs in the catalog without prior notice where circumstances necessitate change.

Students who are in continuous enrollment shall have the option of satisfying requirements which were in effect at the time of first enrollment, or the catalog in effect at the time of the petition to graduate.
