- Revisions to Student Learning Outcomes for BUSI 1A, 22, 42, 44, 49, 54, 60, 62, 64 (cross-listed HOSP 64), 88 (cross-listed AUTO 88), 120A, and 131
 - o Gamble displayed a chart of the current SLOs in CurricUNET/Tractdat and the proposed new SLOs
 - o Is it possible to measure the SLO that addresses every piece/aspect of that outcome?
 - o Helpful to have sample assessment tools to address questions regarding outcomes
 - o Rolling SLOs into one, does it mask inefficiencies in a particular area?
 - Assessing outcomes should not be just about students grades within the contents of the class where are students having difficulty addressing aspects of outcomes?
 - o Better education could potentially be needed for assessing outcomes
 - o Provide an example of an assessment tool for a course with 1 SLO
