## **BP 3250** Institutional Planning

The Superintendent/President shall ensure that the District has and implements a broad-based comprehensive, systematic, and integrated system of planning that involves appropriate segments of the college community and the community-at-large and is supported by institutional effectiveness research.

Institutional planning shall include plans required by law, including, but not limited to:

- Educational Master Plan
- Facilities Plan
- Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Plan
- Student Equity Plan
- Student Success and Support Program Plan
- Technology Plan
- Transfer Center Plan
- Cooperative Work Experience Plan
- Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) Plan

The Superintendent/President shall submit those plans (as required by Title 5) to the Governing Board for approval.

The Superintendent/President shall inform the Governing Board about the status of institutional planning and ensure that the Governing Board has an opportunity to assist in developing the general institutional mission and goals for the comprehensive institutional plans.
