4400

BP 4400 Continuing Education Programs

The District shall maintain a continuing education program that will enhance cultural and personal enrichment opportunities for the community by offering a varied schedule of courses, speakers, and other activities of significant quality and merit.

The continuing education program shall be designed to contribute to the physical, intellectual, economic, and/or civic development of the individuals or groups enrolled in it.

Continuing education courses shall be open for admission of adults and of minors who can benefit from the programs.

No General Fund monies may be expended to establish or maintain community services courses. Students involved in continuing education courses shall be charged a fee not to exceed the cost of maintaining the courses. Courses may also be offered for remuneration by contract or with contributions or donations of individuals or groups.
