We need to be careful not to set the bar too low and have every intro course become GE. It might prompt CAC to reconsider which courses fit in this area once it is better defined. Rachel recommended that CAC agendize this topic in order to reconsider/reevaluate the GE area definitions to avoid this issue in the future. BUSC 126B Google Drive: Introduction to Spreadsheets	 Back for review again this year under area E2 Career Exploration. He Seon clarified that this is being submitted again. Was submitted for GER previously in 2016 and was denied. But then in 2017 BUSC 126A was approved and it is a similar course. So it does not make sense to approve a126A but not 126B so it is on the list to reconsider. Fred argues that it is not a specific career exploration course, instead it is a skill that you can use in any career, therefore is not a good candidate for area E2. Beth, based on the #3 example under the area E2 guidelines it may have justified approving BUSC 126A. Based on Fred's motion, LaRon suggested we cannot single out one BUSC course, we should look at all of them. Cathryn reminded the group about our movement toward Guided Pathways and the need to focus our curriculum rather than increasing options. We need to be careful not to provide too many options. The group discussed reevaluating area E2 courses after revisiting the area E2 definition/guidelines.
