Library Mission

The Library will provide and organize information to support the diverse instruction programs and services of the College so that all patrons, through instruction, can become critical and effective users of information.

Library Service Area Outcomes

- study individually or collaboratively in a welcoming environment with supportive staff
- study and explore ideas in an environment that is healthy, safe, and well-maintained
