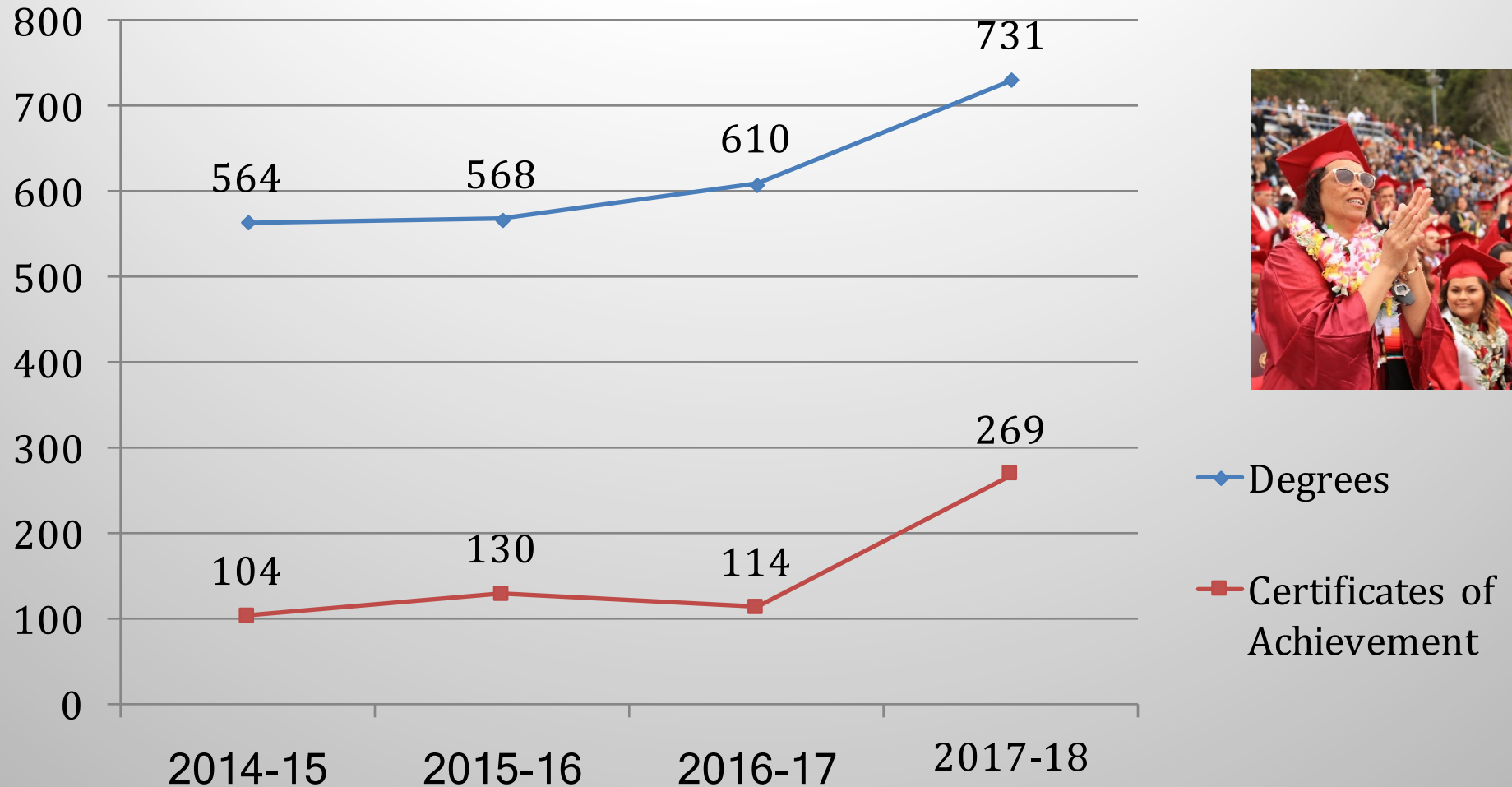

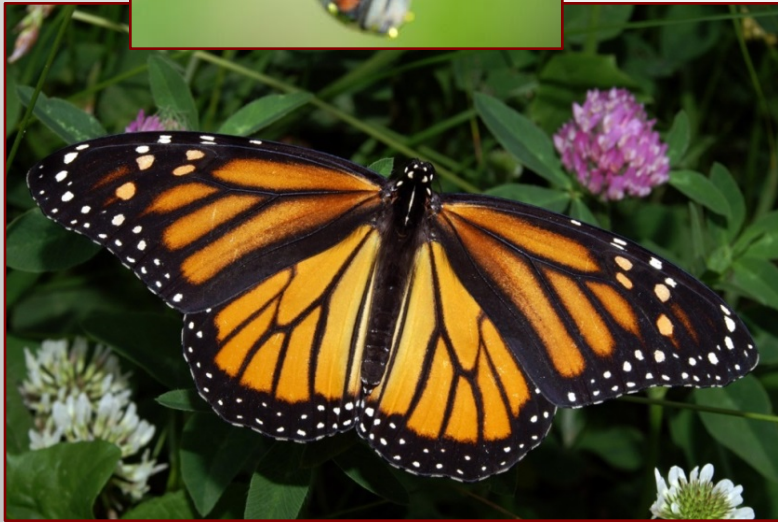

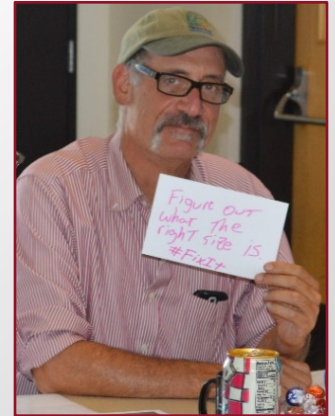
- Follow-Up Report to the ACCJC
