- English Department AB 705 AAAG Notes
  - o 'Eligibility for English 1A' and 'Eligibility for English 111' need to be removed from courses and in curriculum systems
  - o Suggested transfer level courses have a course advisory of ENGL 1A
  - o TBD accelerated English classes
  - o LaRon is concerned about a blanket approach suggested each division/department should make determination for what is best for the discipline
    - Thought it could affect enrollment if advisory is "Completion of ENGL 1A" sometimes, a percentage of first semester students do not want to take courses with advisories, and seeing "Completion of ENGL 1A" might scare a student off
