A. Dual Enrollment Update (3:45-4:15)

Presentation by Dean Knolle on updates to administrative procedures and policies regarding dual enrollment staffing and faculty evaluation

Future topics:

- Faculty selection and course selections

- Professional development
- Faculty evaluations and how it might look like

Select classes that are GE and/or transfer programs.

Enrollment is 563 HS students for Fall 2018. 35% of students are more than likely to complete college if they take at least two dual enrollment classes

Two Math courses right now.

- Work with divisions to discuss what courses can be selected that may be appropriate for Dual Enrollment. Avoid wish list from HS.
- HS faculty that teach at MPC currently have to go through the hiring process by MPC until a better plan is determined. Faculty hiring selection propose process given for some ideas.

Dual enrollment students rise our numbers in success and retention.

- Student evals for Dual Enrollment faculty will not be held against them. Student surveys will be handed to that faculty after the semester is over.
- Professional development: faculty orientation, mentorship
