## **BP 4100 Graduation Requirements for Degrees and Certificates**

References: Education Code Section 70902(b)(3); Title 5 Sections 55060 et seq.

*Note:* This policy is legally required.

The District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science to those students who have completed the degree-applicable requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in degree applicable courses. Students must also complete the general education residency and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Achievement upon successful completion of a minimum of 18 or more semester units designed to develop certain capabilities that may be oriented to career or general education as recommended by the MPC Curriculum Committee.

The [CEO] President/Superintendent shall establish procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements that include appropriate involvement of the MPC Curriculum Advisory Committee. The procedures shall assure that graduation requirements are published in the District's catalogs and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
