

- c. Alternative platforms and mobile computing,
- d. Adaptive technology for students with disabilities,
- e. Classroom instructional technology (smart classrooms & instructional computer labs)
- f. Specialized computer instruction (CTE, Auto Tech, Physics, etc.),
- g. Staff use of technology for Student Services, Academic Affairs, and Administrative S
 - h. Institutional technology (data center, infrastructure, telephone & paging, etc.)
- Website technology.



So what is getting done?

- New Network Switches have been approved for purchase - Implemented by the end of Nov '13 -> Network Engineers starting prep work (John Kalina)
- Web RFP is VERY Near completion
- Revised Tech Plan draft will be ready for shared governance dissemination by end of Oct/ early Nov
- Initiatives are being categorized and prioritized
- Thin Client Options are being evaluated

What is Next?

- Improved WiFi Services
- Refresh Strategy
- Updated Acceptable Use Agreement
- Approval of purchases from One-time Funding
 - Categories
 - Improve Website
 - Technology Infrastructure
 - Network
 - WiFi
 - Campus Computer, AV
 - Accessibility / Communication / Training

One-time Funding

- \$300,000 contingency money allocated to Technology Committee to approve purchases
- Approved by College Council -> May '13
- FY 13/14 One-time monies will not reduce ongoing budgeting deficits
- Tech Committee will develop clearly defined ranking and other criteria for spending – Next Meeting Oct 4th
- Examples:
 - Ranking -> Scope of Impact, Institutional Needs
 - Criteria -> At least 2 quotes

Additional Tech Committee Value to MPC

 Technology is now being vetted through a committee before decisions are made and technical solutions are implemented
