BP 2010 Board Membership

The Board shall consist of five (5) members elected by the qualified voters of the District. Members shall be elected by trustee area, as created by the Monterey County Board of Education on August 11, 2008, and as defined in Board Policy 2100 – Board Elections.

Any person who meets the criteria contained in law is eligible to be elected or appointed a member of the Board.

Employees of the District must resign from their positions at MPC before being sworn into office as appointed or elected members of the Governing Board.

No member of the Governing Board shall, during the term for which they are elected, hold an incompatible office.

No member of the Board of Trustees shall, during the term for which they were elected, be eligible to serve on the governing board of a high school district whose boundaries are coterminous with those of the community college district.
