Chapter 2 Board of Trustees 2800

## BP 2800 Complaints and Charges Made to the Governing Board

All charges or complaints made against employees of the District and presented to the Governing Board or to individual Board members directly shall be referred to the Superintendent/President for investigation and report unless they refer directly to the Superintendent/President. Complaints regarding the Superintendent/President will be submitted to the Board Chair.

Any complaints received by an individual Board member will be referred to the Superintendent/President for investigation. Following the investigation, the Superintendent/President will then communicate to the person making the complaint with a copy to all Board members. If the Board member prefers, the Superintendent/ President will communicate the Superintendent/President's findings back to the Board member, who will be responsible for contacting the complainant, and copies of the investigation report will be sent to all Board members.
