GOVERNING BOARD POLICIES

BP 3550 Drug Free Environment and Drug Prevention Program

The District shall be free from all unlawful drugs and from the unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illicit drugs. Furthermore, the District shall be free from the possession, use, or distribution of alcohol and/or cannabis products by students and employees, to include misuse or illegal use of legally prescribed medications (or drugs).

The unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession, or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in all facilities under the control and use of the District.

Any student or employee who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action (consistent with local, state, or federal law), which may include referral to an appropriate rehabilitation program, suspension, demotion, expulsion, or dismissal.

The Superintendent/President shall assure that the District distributes annually to each student and employee the information required by the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989 and complies with other requirements of the Act.
