Chapter 5 Student Services

5020

BP 5020 Nonresident Tuition

Nonresident students shall be charged nonresident tuition for all units enrolled, unless specifically required otherwise by law.

Not later than March 1 of each year, the Superintendent/President shall bring to the Governing Board for approval an action to establish nonresident tuition for the following fiscal year. The fee shall be calculated in accordance with guidelines contained in applicable state regulations and/or the California Community College Attendance Accounting Manual.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures regarding collection, waiver, and refunds of nonresident tuition. The nonresident tuition shall be published in the MPC Catalog and the Schedule of Classes.
