Next Steps for International Students

Now that you have received your I-20, here is a helpful checklist. Or, visit the <u>Admitted Students</u> tab on the International Student web page. Follow the steps in order to successfully become an MPC student. Students must complete all the steps in order to successfully on-board to MPC.

1. Pay SEVIS fee

Begin the process of applying for your F-1 visa by paying your SEVIS fee. Visit www.fmjfee.com to submit your I-901 SEVIS fee. After payment, schedule an F-1 visa appointment at your local US Embassy. Once you have obtained your F-1 visa, you can proceed to the next step.

2. Complete a U.S. MPC application

Students must submit a free, online U.S. application for admissions to MPC and enter their F-1 visa information on the residency page. Visit www.mpc.edu/apply to access the online application portal. Once your application has been successfully submitted, you will receive a welcome email containing your 9-digit MPC ID number (ex: 901234567)

3. Complete an English as a Second Language guided self-assessment

Students who submitted a TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo score must complete the ESL guided self-assessment questionnaire and provide their results to the ISP Counselor during their counseling appointment. Information can be found on Assessment website.

4. Schedule a counseling appointment

Students will need to create an Education Plan prior to registration. Visit the <u>ISP online</u> counseling system to make an appointment.

5. Meet with the ISP Coordinator

Students will need to meet with the Program Coordinator after they have an education plan on file to discuss important F-1 visa information, pay health insurance fee and clear any registration holds. Student can register for classes after registration and insurance holds are cleared.

6. RSVP and attend the mandatory ISP orientation

7. **Submit I-94**

Visit https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/194 to complete your I-94. Print the confirmation page and submit it to ISP staff.
