State budget update - Highlights

- Budget Act passed in late june preserves Community College funding at 2019/20 levels
- Uncertainty regarding State Revenues results in use of Deferrals similar to past practices. We are allowed to recognize revenues earned but not paid to us during the fiscal year (cash flows are impacted).
- No COLA
- Extended deadlines for Adopted Budget to October 31, 2020

State Budget Update - Restricted Resources

- New COVID 19 Block grant
- Student Success Grant continues to be funded (Student Financial Aid)
- Categorical programs were not subject to statewide reduction, however those that typically receive COLA will not receive a COLA this year. 2021 Grant allocations are beginning to be provided by the State Chancellor's office.
- Significant programs that had proposed reductions were not cut:
 - Strong Workforce
 - Student Equity and Achievement

MPC Budget

 The Governor's May Revise included an 8% reduction to Education as a result of the revised Prop 98 calculations. This was <u>eliminated</u> in the state adopted budget. However, the State is planning to defer payments into 2022 budget year (current estimate is near \$7 million for MPC)

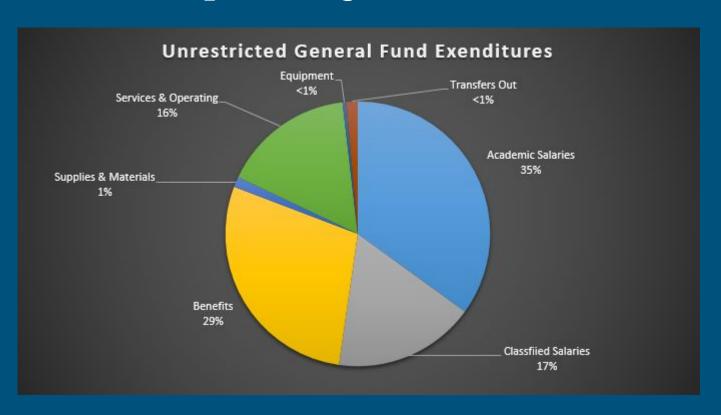
