AP 5150 Extended Opportunity Programs and Services

The District shall establish and support the College's Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) for students who might otherwise not have equal opportunity and access to education programs because of financial need and educational disadvantages. Such services may include recruitment and outreach, counseling, retention, transfer services, grants, work-study, and book vouchers.

Title 5 guidelines and the Education Code provide the legal authority for the criteria for eligibility of EOPS programs and the requirements for data collection, staff management, review and evaluation of programs and services, submission of reports, goals and objectives, and the annual program plan.

For detailed EOPS policies and procedures, refer to the annual EOPS Program Plan on file with the Vice President of Student Services.
