WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A HISPANIC SERVING INSTITUTION?

The Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI) Designation Eligibility designation qualifies higher education institutions to receive grants under the Title V and Title III, Part A, Programs. HSI designation also places importance on retaining and graduating, and Transferring our Latinx and Low-Income students. Monterey Peninsula College first became an HSI in 2011 when 25% enrollment of Latinx students was achieved. In 2018 Monterey Peninsula College received its first Title V Grant- Ready, Set, Transfer. Followed by a second grant in 2020, Engage Promote Connect. We hope you enjoy our quarterly newsletter, where we will keep you updated on all of our upcoming events and initiatives.
