- [] Unofficial copies of ALL academic transcripts - with literal English translation. All previous academic work must be included, **including high school, college, university, technical school, English Language Programs, and all postsecondary education, whether in the USA or another country.** Syllabi of course work may be requested by MPC at a later date. We require copies both of your diplomas **and** your academic transcripts which list course names, grades and duration.

Official academic transcript (stamped, sealed, and unopened) of the **most recent institution** which lists course names, grades, and duration. Official transcripts must be translated into English and be sent directly from the school/institution to MPC..

Official TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo Score Report - for all applicants for whom English is not their native (first) language. TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo test result must be recent-within two years of application to MPC.
