We require copies both of your diplomas and your academic transcripts which list course names, grades and duration.

- Official TOEFL/IELTS Score Report - for all applicants for whom English is not their native (first) language. TOEFL/IELTS test result must be recent-within two years of application to MPC.

- Statement of Purpose; a short essay stating why you wish to study at our college.

- Confidential financial statement:
 - (i) Current Bank Statement, with the U.S. equivalency, from each sponsor
 - (ii) Signature and amount of support indicated on MPC Confidential Financial Statement.
 - (iii) Financial documents must be current and dated within 6 months of school start date.
