AUTO 100: Remove Advisory

Company Officer Certificate of Achievement: Replace FPTC 135 with FPTC 106 (to align with AS)

Dance Associate in Arts – Remove General Education Outcome

Dietary Manager Certificate of Achievement - Add the following language to the Program Description: "Earning an additional 2 or 4 year degree in Nutrition and/or Hospitality in addition to this certificate may improve salary and employment in this area."

ENGR 12L: Revise Content to align with C-ID Descriptor for resubmission to address Conditional Approval

Horticulture Certificate of Achievement - Replace the specialization name "Arboriculture" with "Tree Care Specialist" where applicable

Horticulture Associate in Science Degree - Add the Outcome "Identify two hundred horticultural plants by common name, scientific name and cultivar" to match the CA; Replace the specialization name "Arboriculture" with "Tree Care Specialist" where applicable

Landscape Pest Management - Certificate of Achievement - Revise the description as follows: "This certificate gives students a grounding in the principles of integrated pest management in landscape and nursery settings. Integrated pest management stresses Identification and monitoring of plant pests and diseases and finding the least harmful control method for the situation. Students

will be familiar with invertebrate and vertebrate pests, fungal and bacterial diseases, nutritional deficiencies and weed control, and with the variety of possible control strategies. Students with this certification will be prepared for the Qualified Applicator Certificate exam administered by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation, a widely recognized certification among horticultural employers."

SIGN 90: Remove Advisory

The following courses still have the Advisory "ENGL 111 or ENSL 110 and ENSL 155" (this was changed to "ENGL 111 or ENSL 11" in the Catalog, but likely not yet approved by CAC): SIGN 90, ARTS 9A, AUTO 100, BUSI 30, BUSI 42, BUSI 52, BUSC 141, BUSC 142, BUSC 143, BUSC 151, BUSC 170, CSIS 77, CSIS 114, ECED 80, ENGL 1A, ENGL 1AE, REAL 53, REAL 56

- BP: The transfer-level courses should have an Advisory of "Completion of or concurrent enrollment in ENGL 1A." The 100-level course Advisory can say "ENGL 111 or ENSL 11" – as for ENGL 1A and 1AE.
