Internship Benefits

- Earn college units for participation through Cooperative Education email: mpc_coop@mpc.edu for details
- Stipends vary based on the number of hours, earn up to \$1,500 for interning

Who can apply

- Students who meet the criteria below can apply for the stipend:
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Financial aid on file at MPC for the 2022-23 school year
- Be considered low-income according to financial aid guidelines (i.e., CA Promise Grant eligibility)

Program Requirements

- Must be an internship with a non-profit, small business (fewer than 50 employees), or start-up venture with limited funding for paid internships
- Meet with an MPC COOP Instructor to determine if you can earn college units through Cooperative Work Experience
- As part of the application process, include a resume and internship cover letter with this application, support can be provided by career services to create a resume/letter

Steps to Apply

STEP 1: Schedule a meeting with the Work-Based Learning Coordinator for assistance with finding an internship

Once you're in the process of securing an internship, complete the application. You can pick up a physical step 2: copy at the Career & Transfer Resource Center at the MPC Monterey Campus, or at the Marina Education Center, Room 201.

Turn in your internship application as soon as possible STEP 3: (priority deadline is April 15). Please submit a complete application, with all supporting documents to Carla Becerra Work-Based Learning Coordinator at cbecerra@mpc.edu
