- ♦ Our current state →
 Informs our stakeholders
- Answers these questions:
 - > Who are we?
 - > Why do we exist?
 - > Whom do we serve?





Vision

- ♦ Our future state → Inspires
 & motivates
- Answers these questions:
 - What do we aspire to achieve?
 - > Where are we going?





Values

- What we stand for?
 - > Our core beliefs
 - > Principles for how we act
- Examples:
 - > Inclusion
 - > Academic excellence
 - > Collaboration
