VII. Discussion Agenda

Changes to Title 5 – Associate degree requirements and revisions to MPC GE:

- Our MPC GE Standards need to be revised and approved by the Senate by the end of the semester.

- Draft of Ethnic Studies competency (effective 2024-2025): Committee determined that it would be easier – and clearer for students – to draft the Standards language for our Ethnic Studies GE Area, then list specific courses within a competency applicable to 2024-2025 (see CCC FDRG Competencies).

- Some ETNC courses have GE Area D approval and will not be revised to integrate competencies.

- Proposed timeline: Draft Ethnic Studies GE Standard in collaboration with Kendra -> Reconsiderations for MPC GE Areas F and E -> Revisions to MPC GE Area A2, separate Area for Math -> Revision to Oral Communication Standard
