1. Review and recommendation of proposal coordinated between the Academic Senate and the Curriculum Advisory Committee: Including DEIAA in the Curriculum Proposal Process

- CAC recommends adding an advisory statement to the draft IDEAA document regarding the potential impact(s) of course revisions to articulation and existing GE approval(s), and separating out language relative to Course Content and Objectives

- The ideas addressed in this document may be negotiated within another step or level in the Technical Review process (similar to the DE Committee); one committee

member offered that we might benefit from developing a "standard" or basis of objectivity from which Faculty could consider integrating IDEAA into their curriculum

- CAC also supports identifying and promoting the IDEAA document as a "reference" for Faculty

2. Common Course Numbering update

- Latest communication through ASCCC requests the convention of discipline Faculty in Communication Studies, English, Math, Political Science, and Psychology to draft Common Course Numbering descriptors for six of the highest enrolled general education courses: College Composition, Argumentative Writing and Critical Thinking, Public Speaking, Introduction to Statistics, Introduction to American Government and Politics, and Introduction to Psychology

- The CCC Chancellor's Office has determined August 15, 2024 as the date by which these descriptors shall be finalized. In support, ASCCC will convene virtual intersegmental discipline meetings on June 12, 18, and 24. After these meetings, ASCCC will call a smaller group of Faculty together to finalize the descriptors by the deadline.
