

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. **How do I apply for an on-campus job?**
 - Must be enrolled in 6 units or more at MPC
 - Contact MPC Financial Aid Office to fill out the financial aid application and make sure your financial aid file is complete
 - Fill out FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov
 - Request Federal Work Study [HERE](#)
If you don't qualify for financial aid you still can apply for on-campus jobs. However, they are limited.
2. **How do I apply for an off-campus job?**
 - Go to [MPC Careerlinks](#) and create an account to search and apply for jobs
3. **What is Federal Work Study (FWS)?**
 - Federal Work Study is a federally funded program. You must qualify for financial aid to apply for Federal Work Study.
4. **What kinds of jobs are available for work-study students?**
 - Library technician, tutoring, office assistant, teacher's aide, fitness assistant, and many other positions on-campus at MPC.
5. **What is the hourly wage to work on campus?**
 - California minimum wage and up.
6. **When do I get paid?**
 - Monthly on the 10th after 2:00pm.
7. **Where do I pick up my work-study check?**
 - Your check will be mailed to you on the 10th of every month. An email will be sent to you if you're receiving a check in the mail.
8. **How many units do I have to enroll in at MPC to apply for an FWS on-campus job?**
 - Minimum of 3 units for summer and 6 units for spring or fall.
9. **How many units do I have to enroll in at MPC to apply for an off-campus job?**
 - None
10. **How many jobs off campus can I apply for at a time?**
 - You can apply for as many as you want
