Eligibility

To qualify for Federal Parent PLUS Loan you must:

- ⇒ Apply for an FSA ID at https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/sign-in/landing
- ⇒ Student completes 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
- ⇒ Pass a credit check conducted by the loan servicing agency. A Parent PLUS loan applicant who is determined to have an adverse credit history <u>may</u> receive the loan if he or she obtains a co-signer for the loan who passes the credit check.

Application Process

- 1. Submit a 2024-2025 Parent PLUS Loan Application to the MPC Student Financial Services Office.
- 2. Go to https://studentaid.gov/plus-app/
- 3. Log In=> Loans & Grants => PLUS Loans: Grad PLUS & Parent PLUS" => "I am a Parent of a Student" => click START and follow the instructions provided.
- 4. Go to https://studentaid.gov/mpn/parentplus/landing Log in => Loans & Grants => "MPN" => I'm a Parent of an Undergraduate Student => START and follow the instructions provided.
- 5. At any time you can request to adjust your Parent Plus Loan amount from our MPC Student Financial Services Office.
- 6. The interest rate for the 2024-2025 year is 9.08%.
- 7. An origination fee of 4.228% will be deducted from each disbursement.
