The MPC Fitness Center Assistant position is an opportunity to work in the Fitness Center during the open lab times. The job description includes general organization and cleaning of the facility. The MPC Fitness Center is located in the Kinesiology/Athletics Department.

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Provide support to the instructor
- Cleaning the fitness equipment using disinfectant sanitizer and sweeping.
- Organizing weights and training equipment.
- Reporting and logging in of broken equipment or equipment in need of repair.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

### Minimum Requirements

- Must apply for Federal Financial Aid and be eligible for Federal Work-Study
- Be a currently enrolled student at MPC



- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 units for Fall/Spring term or a minimum of 3 units for the Summer term
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA
- Must be a student in good standing and not on Academic, Progress, or Disciplinary Probation
- Must have an updated Education plan on file at all times

- Lift and move weights up to 25lbs
