<p>Discussion Agenda</p> <p>Lyndon Schutzler Mark Clements</p>	<p>Physical Fitness/Physical Education Graduation Requirement</p> <p>Lyndon and Mark came to the committee to discuss adding an MPC GE requirement for one unit of physical activity. They cited the benefits of such a requirement in providing a means for students to improve and to maintain personal health and fitness throughout the lifespan. The addition of a physical activity requirement would also address a serious national concern related to the spiraling costs of health care and social welfare resulting from the lack of physical fitness and activity across all ages. These costs will continue to increase as the U.S. population ages.</p> <p>They reported 80% of Southern California Community Colleges currently have a physical education requirement as do a number of Northern California Community Colleges. Specifically, De Anza requires 2 units of PE activity and the College of the Marin requires 1 unit PE for graduation.</p> <p>Michael Gilmartin pointed out that the addition of any new GE requirement must be approved by the Senate by March in order to be included in the 2012-2013 catalog.</p>	<p>Discussion will continue.</p>
