<p>Discussion Agenda</p>	<p>Student Information System (SIS) - Michael Gilmartin The campus will be converting to a new information system on Sept. 16th. The new software will, in accordance with the Chancellor’s Office rules, no longer allow certain revisions, including: TOP code, SAM code, and number of units. Changes to these items will require that a new course be created. Discussion will be needed regarding new rules for CurricUNET which currently allows changes to these elements without requiring the creation of a new course.</p> <p>Gainful Employment – Michael Gilmartin There are new federal regulations, related to the 90 unit limit on financial aid. These regulations require the collection of data linked to programs for each student individually by Social Security Number. Data will need to be collected for the last four years. Additionally, each department homepage must contain disclosure statements for their programs which include employment, completion time, costs, etc. (ADMJ example: http://www.mpc.edu/academics/lifescience/admofjustice/Pages/default.aspx). There are also new SOC codes which are linked to O*NET, the U.S. Department of Labor, Employment & Training Administration, online occupation information and outlook website.</p> <p>CAC Chair – Lynn Iwamoto Lynn informed the committee that she is in line to assume the position of Mathematics Department Chair in April 2013.
