<p>Discussion</p> <p>CurricUNET and SB 1440 Issues</p> <p>Michael Gilmartin</p>	<p>Michael updated the committee on a recent conversation he had with George Tamas, CEO of GoverNET, and Steven Thyberg, VP of GoverNET, who informed him that they will soon be hiring more staff which will enable them to address requests for changes and fixes more quickly. Michael encouraged CurricUNET users to contact Laura Mock to add any issues or concerns to the list of fixes we are requesting. Upcoming changes to CurricUNET include adding CID codes and repeatability. GoverNET has an online catalog development software package available at no cost to CurricUNET campuses. MPC will look into whether or not to pursue the use of this software.</p> <p>The Chancellor’s Office is ready to let community colleges submit curriculum documents directly from their local CurricUNET. Community colleges may be given permission for local approval of non-credit courses through CurricUNET.</p> <p>All but one of the SB 1440 programs submitted to the Chancellor’s Office has been rejected so far. MPC will need to identify necessary supporting course documentation for the three programs we are planning to submit by Fall 2011.
