 The chancellor's office is looking into tutoring classes because of possibility of Title 5 violation. The Chancellor's office is not looking the other way anymore. It's ok to have more tutoring classes. Basic skills/study skills classes can be tutor classes but tutoring must be addressed in the outline. Other class levels do not produce FTS thus different monies. Tutoring courses that need to revise the course outline to say basic skills: SSKD 400, PERS 400, ENGL 400, MATH 440, reading, ENSL 400, etc. The outlines need to be fixed so the MPC does not loose FTS. 1 year to update Students who should be in the tutoring sessions should be enrolled in a basic skills class.
