Approval Process Michael Gilmartin	Michael distributed a list of 996 courses which need to be updated. Additionally, several hundred courses outside of the divisions will need to be updated. It is imperative to get these courses updated as soon as possible. Because of the large number of courses which need to be updated and approved by CAC Michael suggests that the committee adopt a Consent Agenda. The Consent Agenda would contain courses which have been through the Technical Review process and would contain only minor changes. Consent Agenda courses would be addressed and approved as a block. Courses requiring individual review and discussion by the committee would be addressed individually as part of an Action Agenda. Additionally, Michael asked committee members to inform their divisions to anticipate the approval process for a new course to take a year.	Effective immediately, the committee will adopt a Consent Agenda and an Action Agenda to expedite the reviewing and approval of courses.
Stand Alone Course training Lynn Iwamoto	By the end of September the chair of each community college's curriculum committee is required by the Chancellor's Office to hold Stand Alone Course approval training. Lynn would like to hold this training on either Wednesday, Sept. 10 th or 17 th . The committee agreed that Sept. 17 th would be the better date. Variable Unit Courses Michael Gilmartin	Michael informed the committee that there is a need to develop guidelines for variable unit, repeatable courses. This has become an issue since the college became a member of the South Bay Consortium. The Consortium wants MPC to align exactly to their practices; however, they calculated hours and units differently than does MPC. Michael would like a volunteer to work with him in establishing guidelines which would be used in working with the South Bay Consortium.
