Goal 1: Support and advance academic excellence.

Objective 1.1: Create opportunities for faculty and staff to enhance their knowledge, share ideas, engage in dialog, and collaborate.

Objective 1.2: Meet classroom instruction needs.

Goal 2: Create pathways to student success.

Objective 2.1: Define “student success,” recognizing the diverse goals and needs of MPC students.

Objective 2.2: Strengthen and institutionalize collaboration between Student Services and Academic Affairs.

Objective 2.3: Improve the coordination and accessibility of academic support for diverse student learners.

Objective 2.4: Maintain and strengthen partnerships with high schools and transfer institutions.

Objective 2.5: Develop and implement strategies to reduce barriers that negatively affect student success.

Goal 3: Support and encourage diversity throughout the institution. [*Question: How is “diversity” defined?”*]

Objective 3.1: Create/maintain an inviting recruitment process for all potential students.

Objective 3.2: Provide campus and community activities that reflect the diversity of our students and community.

Objective 3.3: Develop and implement hiring recruitment strategies to encourage a diverse pool of applicants.

Objective 6.1: Review current levels of personnel to determine most critical faculty and staff need.

Objective 6.2: Create education and funding plan to help the college support its current and future personnel needs.

Objective 6.3: Attract and retain the best-qualified employees by continuing to increase compensation for full and part-time faculty and staff.
