3105 Pre-Requisites and Co-requisites

Title 5 Sections 55000 and 55003

The Superintendent/President is authorized to establish pre requisites, co requisites and advisories on recommended preparation for courses in the curriculum. All such prerequisites, co requisites and advisories shall be established in accordance with the standards set out in Title 5. Any pre requisites, co requisites or advisories shall be necessary and appropriate for achieving the purpose for which they are established. The procedures shall include a way in which a pre-requisite or co-requisite may be challenged by a student on grounds permitted by law. Pre requisites, co requisites and advisories shall be identified in District publications available to students.

Academic Senate revisions 12/2/10

The <u>Governing Board authorizes the Superintendent/President is authorized</u> to oversee the development of <u>a-policies and procedures</u> whereby the District relies primarily upon the Curriculum Advisory Committee to establish pre-requisites, co-requisites, and advisories on recommended preparation for courses in the curriculum. The Curriculum Advisory Committee shall be established in a way that is mutually agreeable to the District Administration and the Academic Senate.

All pre-requisites, co-requisites, and advisories shall be established in accordance with the standards set out forth in Title 5 so that they aid in improving student success, maintaining academic standards, and promoting equitable access. Pre-requisites and co-requisites shall be necessary and appropriate for achieving the purpose for which they are established. Procedures shall be established that enable any student to challenge pre-requisites and co-requisites on grounds permitted by law. Pre-requisites, co-requisites, and advisories shall be identified and clearly explained in District publications available to students. Pre-requisites, co-requisites, and advisories for all courses shall be reviewed during the program review process- at least once every six years, except that prerequisites and corequisites for vocational courses and programs shall be reviewed every two years.
